



Year 7 Catch-up Premium Grant Report: 2016-17

Secondary schools receive the premium to help to support year 7 pupils who fail to reach the government's "expected standard" - previously a level 4 - in reading and Maths by the time they leave primary school.

In 2016-17 the allocation of funds for this purpose to Forest Gate Community School was **£23,358**.

In 2017-18 the allocation of funds for this purpose to Forest Gate Community School was **£23,654**.

Each year we use our catch-up premium to employ additional qualified English and Maths teachers. We teach weaker students in small groups and booster sessions. During the academic year 2017-18 we will use our funding to employ additional teaching staffs in English and Maths departments.

In 2016/17 the impact of the intervention can be directly seen through levels of progress made.
